A man who has been with us serving the Lord since 2006 went to Vision Baptist College in New Jersey the end of January. **Jon Pierre** has grown steadily over the years and I have been able to teach him over a dozen institute classes. He needed to finish his preparation to be equipped to plant churches here in New York City, as the Lord has led him to do. Pray for him in this endeavor. My son in law and daughter, Justin and Stephanie Rodriguez, are working with the teens now. They are doing a good job and are very excited to be used of the Lord. They had a very good meeting in January with 26 teens present and four made decisions to accept Jesus as their Saviour. God has deemed to teach me some lessons and I am listening! I have needed to rest and or sleep a couple of hours during the day, and pace myself. This past weekend went well and I am building endurance!

Our Vision Service went very well as we looked back over the past year. We are grateful to the Lord for the 32 recorded salvations and 7 baptisms. We had a tremendous fall program in which we had good attended services, salvations, and encouraging for all! Our theme for 2015 is "Strengthen the Brethren - Lengthen Ourselves". Two main things we are praying for is to see 10 new families added to our church this year, and for more people to attend Sunday School! We have a strong emphasis on reaching the lost in every service, every activity, and in our weekly outreach. It keeps the gospel before people so that they might know that Jesus loves them and died for them!

Pray that we would have more men to help serve in our church; with Jon Pierre at college a huge hole has been left. Several are stepping up, but we need more to grow. Pray for souls to be saved, and that people would help us in discipling them. We need to get some repairs done on our two church vans also. God is so good and faithful in all of our needs. We are grateful to all of our supporting churches for your prayers and finances. We want to thank you for all the gifts, and cards given to us for Christmas.
